Her counseling experience includes working at various organizations such as Atlanta Mission, Family Uplift Inc., Cobb County Department of Family and Children Services, The Clinic for Education, Treatment, and Prevention of Addiction, Dekalb County Community Service Board, Genesis Christian Counseling Center, Family Ties Inc., Community Based Treatment LLC, and Catholic Charities of Atlanta. Jenine is a highly skilled and experienced counselor, with expertise in a range of therapeutic techniques. She is trained in Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, EEG Othmer Neurofeedback, Anger Management, EMDR, Dialectical Behavior Therapy, Triple P Positive Parenting, Trauma and Grief Component Therapy, Prepare/Enrich Marriage Counseling Facilitation, CAMS Training for Assessing and Treating Suicidal Risk, Collaborative Problem Solving, Immigration Evaluations, Rational Living Therapy, Trauma Focused Art Therapy, Shambhala Level 1 and 2 Meditation Warrior training, Mindfulness, Laughter Yoga, and Aromatherapy.

Jenine was a Peace Corps Volunteer in Esmeraldas, Ecuador from 1998-2001. During her volunteer service, she served as a family-atrisk volunteer and took pride in starting more than fourteen community gardens. She also helped to launch a recycled paper business and co-produced a theatrical play on African American history.

During her time at the college, she participated in a semester abroad program and served as a National Institutes of Health Scholar in Wollongong, Australia.
